# MAUSBCYA JUNIOR GOLD QUALIFIER TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All entrants must be current USBC Certified youth members of the State of Massachusetts.
2. All rules and regulations of the USBC will govern this tournament.
3. All Youth Bowlers must abide by USBC Youth Code. This means NO foul language or gestures. NO chewing tobacco, NO playing video games and no electronic devices may be used during squad time and competition. The Tournament Director has the right to disqualify any bowler for failure to comply. Only USBC certified products that meet the youth guidelines can be used.
4. **DRESS CODE:** During check-in, ALL entrants must come neatly dressed, wearing a center issued, mock collared or a lapelled collared shirt, dress slacks, neat jeans, knee length shorts or skirts. NO HEADGEAR OF ANY KIND UNLESS MEDICALLY NECESSARY WITH A DOCTOR'S NOTE. If wearing a collared button down shirt, it must be buttoned at all times. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. (**National Rule 301B Youth**). The Tournament Director will remove any bowler who does not meet the above dress code.
5. Deliberate falsification of an average will result in disqualification, forfeiture of all fees and possible suspension from USBC.
6. All disputes and complaints will be settled by the Tournament Director. All protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of such protested event.
7. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacement hereby agree that the MAUSBCYA, it's officers and agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by war, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the MAUSBCYA.
8. The Tournament Director reserves the right to add or delete squads if necessary. Squad dates and times are assigned on a first come first serve basis. The Tournament Director will assign lanes.
9. All entrants must be current USBC members and Junior gold members in good standing. Both membership cards must be shown at check-in.
10. This tournament is a Scratch Singles Tournament. Six games across 12 lanes.
11. Entry Fee Breakdown: Bowling \$12.00, Junior Gold fee \$40.00.
12. Bowling balls not meeting USBC Standards concerning weight balances, hardness or scuffing during competition are subject to removal for the remainder of the tournament. Bowlers are permitted to use USBC approved ball cleaners for polishes during competition.
13. 1:5 ratio with a major fraction will advance to the Junior Gold National Finals July 9-15, 2011 in Las Vegas. There must be at least 5 entrants of either gender to hold the tournament. To have divisions there needs to be a minimum of five boys and four girls.
14. Only bowlers and tournament officials are allowed in the settee area. No flash photography during competition
15. Ties will be broken by a 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> frame roll-off.
16. There will be 2 practice balls on the starting lanes only. No practice permitted between games.
17. Any corrections to a score recorded by the automatic scorers must be made by a tournament official
18. All USBC rules will apply if otherwise not defined.
