If wearing a collared button down shirt, it must be buttoned at all times.** Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. **(National Rule 301B Youth).** The Tournament Director will remove any bowler who does not meet the above dress code.

MAUSBC YOUTH LEADERS DOUBLES TOURNAMENT RULES

1. All entrants must be current USBC Certified youth members of the State of Massachusetts.
2. All rules and regulations of the USBC will govern this tournament.
3. All Youth Bowlers must abide by USBC Youth Code. This means NO foul language or gestures. NO chewing tobacco, NO playing video games and no electronic devices may be used during squad time and competition. The Tournament Director has the right to disqualify any bowler for failure to comply. Only USBC certified products that meet the youth guidelines can be used.
4. **DRESS CODE:** During check-in, ALL entrants must come neatly dressed, wearing a center issued, mock collared or a lapel collared shirt, dress slacks, neat jeans, knee length shorts or skirts. **NO HEADGEAR OF ANY KIND UNLESS MEDICALLY NECESSARY WITH A DOCTOR'S NOTE.** If wearing a collared button down shirt, it must be buttoned at all times. Youth participants will not wear apparel or use bowling equipment depicting alcohol, tobacco, gambling, an illegal substance or inappropriate language/gestures during competition. **(National Rule 301B Youth).** The Tournament Director will remove any bowler who does not meet the above dress code.
5. Deliberate falsification of an average will result in disqualification, forfeiture of all fees and possible suspension from USBC.
6. All disputes and complaints will be settled by the Tournament Director. All protests must be submitted in writing to the Tournament Director within 72 hours of such protested event.
7. The entrants whose names appear hereon or their authorized replacement hereby agree that the MAUSBCYA, its officers and agents, shall be liable only to the extent of returning entry fees if and when these entrants shall be prevented from bowling any event in the tournament through delay, unexpected yet necessary schedule change or premature termination of the tournament which may be brought about by war, strikes, lockouts, labor difficulties or other causes beyond the control of the MAUSBCYA.
8. The Tournament Director reserves the right to add or delete squads if necessary. Squad dates and times are assigned on a first come first serve basis. The Tournament Director will assign lanes.
9. Entrants must bowl in the order shown on their form. A substitute must bowl in the position of the bowler being replaced. Substitutes must follow the same eligibility rules as the original entrant. No blind scores will be permitted. **NO PACERS WILL BE ALLOWED. THERE WILL BE NO ABSENTEE SCORES ALLOWED. If bringing a replacement, they must register at least 30 minutes prior to squad time.** A substitute is found by the MAUSBCYA Board and a replacement is made at the discretion of the program director.
10. No one other than the bowlers, scorekeepers or Tournament Officials will be permitted in the bowling area. Bowlers must stay in the bowling area during the match unless permission to leave is given by the scorekeeper or Lane Marshall. NO food or beverage will be allowed in the Bowling Area.
11. Automatic foul detectors will be used and observed in every event. If there are any questions as to a foul, the Official Scorekeeper and/or Lane Marshall may make a decision otherwise shall contact the Tournament Director who shall be sole judge in a case of a dispute.
12. Handicap for each event will be computed at 90% of the difference between the bowler's average and 220 for all entrants based on a 3 game series.
13. A late bowler, or one who leaves during a game, will be given ZERO for each frame missed; tardy bowlers shall begin in the frame then being bowled (no make-up allowed). A REPLACEMENT or SUB is official at squad time.
14. Total pin fall of 3 games and handicap. Bowlers will bowl three (3) games across six (6) lanes. If there is a tie for positions being awarded the positions will be combined and the awards will be split equally.
15. Entering Average will be one of the following:
 - a. Entrants will use their highest certified league average as of Jan. 1, 2010 with a 21 game minimum.
 - b. If entrant does not have a January 1, 2010 average then their highest certified current average for a minimum of 21 games as of tournament closing date may be used. (Must be verified prior to the tournament)
 - c. All others will bowl Scratch
 - d. All bowlers may be eligible for re-rating based on a composite of the last (3) three years of MAUSBCYA Tournaments (To include State Singles, YBC, Youth Leaders Doubles and the Annual) based on (12) twelve games. The higher average between composite average minus 10 pins and the tournament entering average shall be used.
16. Awards will be awarded per team based on a minimum of 5 entries per each division.
Division #1- Boys Handicap (11 & Under); Division #2- Girls Handicap (11 & Under); Division #3- Mixed (11 & under); Division #4- Boys Handicap (12 & Over); Division#5- Girls Handicap (12 & Over) ; Division #6- Mixed (12 & Over). Awards will be given in a 1 and 5 ratio. All ages are as of August 1,2009. If there are not enough entries in a division, then divisions will be combined.
17. Additional awards will be awarded if funds are available.
18. You will have 2 practice balls on each of your starting lanes.
